- [Chenghuang Temple Night Market] The only provincial and capital temple in Taiwan, and the only provincial temple. Every Lantern Festival, lanterns and crowds will make the temple lively and colourful. Every year during the Lunar New Year Festival, the city god patrols, attracting the influx of believers from all over the country, and the group effect develops The Hsinchu Chenghuang Night Market, which has just emerged, has become a very popular market attraction in Hsinchu City. The food stalls in the Hsinchu City's Town Temple are always crowded at night and on holidays, and there are long lines in front of the shops, which has become one of Hsinchu's characteristics.'
- [Qingjing Farm Green Green Grassland] 1,800 meters above sea level, is the most popular and beautiful piece of pure land in Qingjing Farm. In the wilderness area, there is an endless stretch of green grassland, green grass in spring, cattle and sheep strolling leisurely among them, just like the scenery of Northland; the scenery is like a picture, the climate is pleasant, and it is called "the peach on the fog", a famous sightseeing in the central region Tourist attraction.
- [Qingjing Farm Swiss Garden] The beautiful Northern European atmosphere at the Small Swiss Garden has given it the name of "Taiwan's Little Switzerland" and "Paradise in the Mist".
- [Carton King] Huang Fang-liang is a Taiwanese paper artist who not only explores possibilities of paper but also creates more than fifty different products only with paper, whose creative paper company Carton King even holds over 100 patents. Carton King is a perfect result out of the sheer popularity of these papermade products, where snacks, hot pots, afternoon tea and set menus are served. Almost everything seen in this restaurant, from dining room sets to lampshades and pots, is made with corrugated paper – Carton King is no doubt a mindblowing wonderland of fantasy and imagination.
- [Sun Moon Lake Lake Tour] Can watch the lakeside scenery while listening to the captain's guided tour to learn more about the sights and history of Sun Moon Lake. Visit the [Xuanguang Temple] on the island in the lake with a Tang-style architecture, because it was originally planned to temporarily enshrine the top bone relics of Master Xuanzang, there is no green tile and Zhuzhu pillars to reflect, it looks simple and elegant; and it was built by Lintan, you can enjoy Sun Moon Lake nearby The beautiful Lavender water is like being in a beautiful painting environment.

- [Zhongshe flower market taichung] There is a beautiful sea of flowers throughout the year. As the seasons change, you can put on clothes of different colors. This is also the only flower market where tulips are successfully planted at low altitudes in the central Houli region. Every year from January to March, there are many flowers and colours a total of 150,000 tulips bloom in turn. In addition to tulips, a variety of professionally planted flowers bloom in sequence. At present, there are more flowers such as cosmos, perfume lilies, colourful calla lilies, and impatiens. Due to the large planting area, the whole tapestry scene, and the small windmill landscaping on site, it is guaranteed that you can take beautiful photos and take pictures!
- [Feng Chia Night Market] located around Fengjia University in Xitun District, Taichung City. It is currently the largest night market in Taiwan. In the "2010 Featured Night Market Selection Event", it won the prize for its innovative and diverse gourmet snacks. "Taiwan's most delicious night market" title. Every night is always crowded, gourmet snacks are the favourite of tourists.
- [Rainbow Village] is a colourful laneway full of childish paintings; these colourful portraits, animals, and colour blocks, because of their touching local elements, make many tourists come here to watch them. The lonely military village became lively.
- [Tamsui Fisherman's Wharf] is located on the right bank of the estuary of the Tamsui River, with the stretch of Datun Mountains in the east, and Guanyin Mountain across the Tamsui River to the west. It is a natural victory, and since the Taipei MRT Tamsui Line opened to traffic in recent years, a large crowd of visitors poured in. Tamsui Fisherman's Wharf was originally the second fishing port of Tamsui. It is next to the estuary of the Tamsui River. It is a high-quality park for fishing and leisure, leaning on the Tamsui River. At sunset, many people or couples will come to enjoy the scenery at dusk or even at night.
- [Shihlin Night Market] Considered to be the largest and most famous night market in the city. Great place of local handicrafts, clothes, toys, tasty local snacks and souvenirs.
- [Jiufen Old Street] is a streetscape formed by many nostalgic shops, selling some handmade taro balls, grass barley and other snacks. The shopping street in Jiufen is built on the ups and downs of the mountain, with flat roads and stone steps staggered; buildings built on the terrain, walking in the mountain city trails, you can always find a good corner of the scenery. After nightfall, the lights of the thousands of houses in the mountain settlements and the lights of the ships on the sea are lit up. The fishing boats going out to the Shen'ao Fishing Port are making small fires in the vast sea. At the same time, they can enjoy the night view of the mountains and seas. It is a good place for tourists to enjoy the scenery.

- [Shifen Old Street] The old street is connected with train tracks. The unique railway style "passing by the train door" is a good place for shooting at Shifen Station. Even if you visit Shifen Old Street today, you can still feel its lively and diverse appearance. Although the coal mine has ceased mining, the restaurants and sky lantern craft shops in the old streets are still thriving. Also, because of the special place names, the merchants have the idea to launch [ShifenXingFu] postcards so that visitors can send a blessing and give away to the future. With the continuous infusion of new blood, creative products such as Hakka flower cloths and image postcards have also made the Shifen old street business district still "prosperous."
- [Shi-men Ting] Shi-men Ting has been called the "Harajuku of Taipei" and the "Shibuya of Taipei". Ximending is the source of Taiwan's fashion, subculture, and Japanese culture.
